SATELLITE DISHES

Satellite dishes must have covering and **cannot be seen** from the roadway, sidewalk, neighboring property, or from any direction in which the satellite is placed. **No roofline satellites are permitted.**

Two ways in which a homeowner could seek approval for a satellite dish is as follows:

- Satellite dishes must be screened by a **composite or virtual rock** to cover the dish. The composite rocks can be found at www.virtualrock.com
- **Screening material** that is available at Lowe's used for hiding trash cans. If the homeowner chooses garbage screens the antenna can be no farther than 32 inches from the house

Note: A white privacy fence would also be an appropriate means of "hiding" or securing a satellite dish and will be approved by the committee on a case by case basis, so long as the fence is added when the dish is in place.
